

Dear Customer,

This letter is in reference to questions about the possibility of Perfluorooctanoic acid, PFOA, in ISOFlex Packaging films. ISOFlex Packaging does not use any PFOA in the production of any of its films.

ISOFlex Packaging only uses resins that comply with the FDA requirement under 21CFR177.1520 for production of the film for Frozen Specialties.

There is no reasonable expectation of accidental contamination beyond trace quantities existing in the environment

Since we have no reason to suspect PFOA to be present in our films, we do not test for this compound.
