The following information is in reference to the use of phthalates in ISOFlex Packaging films.

Phthalates have been used as plasticizers, to make plastics more flexible. The most common phthalate used as a plasticizer in PVC products is DEHP, Di-2-ethyl hexyl phthalate

ISOFlex Packaging does not use any phthalates in the production of any films. ISOFlex Packaging does not intentionally add any phthalates or any materials that contain phthalates to any of the blends to produce our films. This includes, but is not limited to, DEHP, DBP, BBP, DINP, DIDP or DNOP.

ISOFlex Packaging does not expect to find any phthalates in our films other than trace quantities that might be in the environment. Because we do not add phthalates to our films or have any indication that any of these materials might be in our films we do not test any of our films for phthalates.

ISOFlex Packaging has no expectation of finding any phthalates in any of our films.
