

Dear Customer,

This letter is in reference to questions about the possibility of listed: Vinylidene chloride (VDC) as a substance known to the State of California to cause cancer under California's Proposition 65. OEHHA made this listing final on December 27, 2017. Vinylidene chloride (1, 1-Dichloroethylene), CAS No. 75-35-4, is used as, among other things, a component of some packaging materials, such as polyvinylidene chloride (PVDC).

ISOFlex Packaging does not use any VDC in the production of any of its films.

ISOFlex Packaging only uses LDPE type resins that comply with the FDA requirement under 21CFR177.1520 for the production of the film.

There is no reasonable expectation of accidental contamination beyond trace quantities existing in the environment

Since we have no reason to suspect VDC to be present in our films, we do not test for this compound.
