All orders placed with ISOFlex Packaging are assigned a unique extrusion order number, (Lot Code). Raw materials, additives, packaging materials, work in progress and products are identified throughout ISOFlex's manufacturing processes by this unique extrusion order number to provide for an accurate and timely tracking.

- Once an order is placed for a product an extrusion number is assigned. This extrusion number will be used in all manufacturing/shipping process for traceability purposes.
- Extrusion orders/packets consist of raw & packaging materials used in production with their own individual batch/lot numbers along with manufacturing and shipping instructions.
- All finished products are clearly labeled per customer's specifications and/or regulatory requirements and all records maintained. These code dated labels (may) include:
 - Manufacturing Extrusion Number (always)
 - Scan Code (always)
 - Basic Description
 - Customer PO #
 - Weight
- Once product is labeled in manufacturing, material handlers scan it into the warehouse management system to create a shipping label that includes but not limited to:
 - Manufacturing Extrusion Number (always)
 - Scan Code (always)

All traceability of each individual product is linked to the ISOFlex's Manufacturing Extrusion Number (Lot Code)
