Dear Customer:

We certify that all of our products are made from materials complying with FDA requirements as stated in the Code of Federal Regulations 21 CFR, Sections 177.1520. They also comply with European Directives 90/128/EEC and EU No 10/2011 with the subsequent amendments (including 2002/17/EC, 2002/72/EC, 2004/1/EC, 2004/19/EC and 2005/79/EC, 2008/39/EC, and EU2020/1245, EU2019/37, EU2018/831, EU2017/752, and 2016/1416).

Please be advised that our resin suppliers have received a letter (LONO) from the Health Products and Food Branch (HPFB) of Health Canada, stating that HPFB has no objection to the use in Canada of the subject resins and resulting films in food-contact applications for which the resins are technically suitable.

We further certify that packaging products we produce and supply to you are made from materials complying with CONEG Directive 94/62/EC regarding heavy metals, also known as the Model Toxics in Packaging Legislation. The sum of incidental concentration levels of lead, mercury, cadmium, and hexavalent chromium does not exceed 100 Parts Per Million by weight; we further certify that these metals, if present at levels below the stated amount, were not intentionally added by us during the manufacturing process.

Additionally, our products do not contain ODCs (Ozone Depleting Chemicals) as defined by the Clean Air Amendment of 1990, and all products we supply comply with California Proposition 65 chemical listing.

Packaging materials manufactured by ISOFlex are not and shall not be at the time of delivery thereof adulterated or misbranded within the meaning of said acts or said laws or be articles prohibited from introduction into interstate commerce under the provisions of Section 404 or 505 of the said Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, and are not and do not contain a misbranded hazardous substance or a banned hazardous substance.

Finally, we employ Good Manufacturing Practices in our manufacturing facilities to assure continued compliance with these regulations. The resins we use do not contain any latex in their formulation, nor do we add any latex during our manufacture of any product or packaging we make. ISOFlex Packaging facilities are committed to GFSI (Global Food Safety Initiative) and as such are certified SQF Level 3 manufacturers of polyethylene film and bags.
